



## TORATORA TRAIL AND SKILL DESCRIPTION

---

**SKILL LEVEL REQUIRED; INTERMEDIATE**

**TRAIL GRADE; Grade 3 – 4**

---

**Description:** Wide single track trail with moderate hill climbs, traversing and downhill. No obstacles on trail. Purpose built rollers, tabletops and berms (designed to suit all levels – depends on how you attack them).

**Gradient:** 0-6 degrees for 90% of trail. Max 9 degrees (up to 12 degrees for stretches up to 20m long, with straight, flatter sections to follow).

**Width:** 1.2m wide 95% of the trail. No less than 1m wide 100% of trail.

**Radius of turn:** 1.6 – 2m.

**Surfaces:** 99% smooth and firm.

**Watercourses:** A couple of small creek crossings with approx 80mm max of normal water flow – can easily be ridden.

**Bridge Width:** Only one small bridge. Measures 1.2m wide and no more than a 600mm drop into shallow running creek.

**Obstacles:** 2% of trail has tree roots and small rocks. Very few ruts (wildlife hoof prints - pigs and deer on 5% of trail – no more than 50mm deep by 50mm wide).

**Length:** 14.8km. Approx 3.7km uphill, 4.7km downhill and 6.4km traversing.

**Barriers/Guard rails:** No guard rails or barriers. There is some drop offs on the sides of trail (5% of trail) and on some sharp downhill bends.
